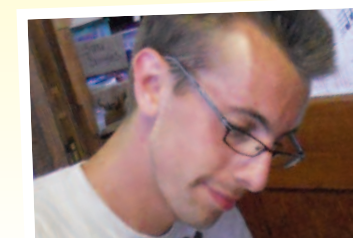

grades 7-12

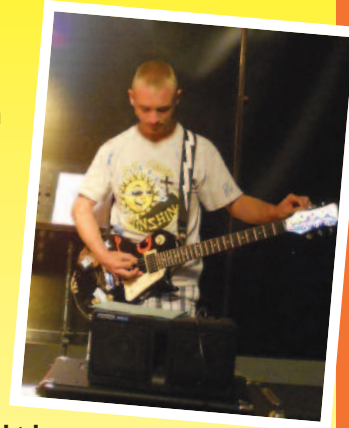


Camp doesn't have to end just because you're a teen! Day Camp Sunshine's Teen Program is designed for young people entering 7th grade and older.

It offers many of the same programs as the Children's Camp, but with more age-appropriate activities and challenging games, and in-depth Bible studies. **Weekly field trips** include the beach, natural and historical parks, and local area attractions. Our mature staff connects with your teens, while encouraging them to make new friends, learn new skills, and develop a closer relationship with God.

Field Trips

The Children's Camp will have 3 field trips throughout the summer. The Teen Camp has weekly field trips. Field trips are included in the week's tuition, but some teen trips may have an additional cost. Signed permission slips must be handed into the Camp Office the day before the trip. On Trip Days all campers must wear Camp T-shirts (included in Camp Tuition) and bring their own lunch, even if not participating in the trip. Supervision and a planned program will be offered to campers remaining at camp. All campers are transported by a commercial bus company.



Note to Parents

We care about the overall health and safety of your child. Children are under the supervision of trained counselors at all times. Counselors are trained in camp programming, child development, and emergency procedures.

All counselors must go through a screening process, which includes reference and background checks. Campers are put into groups according to grade and gender. Two staff members work with each group, and the ratio of counselors to campers is approximately 1:8. We have space for a limited number of children in each group.



Registration Procedures

- 1) Registration online at: <https://securefellowshipcc.com/CAMP/> or visit the Day Camp Sunshine website at: www.DayCampSunshine.org.
- 2) You must pay a minimum of \$50/week to enroll your child and begin the registration process. **Full payment must be made by May 1, 2012.**
- 3) Registration is complete and your child's spot is guaranteed only by full payment of bill and submission of required forms on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 4) Enrollment cancellations and exchanges requested by May 1, 2012, will result in a full refund minus the non-refundable minimum deposit of \$50.00 per week, per child. No refunds or exchanges will be given for cancellations or exchanges requested after May 1, 2012.
- 5) Campers that are waitlisted and paid in full will be moved to session openings on a first come first served basis. If your child is waitlisted and paid in full and is never removed from the waitlist, you will receive a FULL refund for the waitlisted weeks including the \$50.00 non-refundable minimum deposit.
- 6) Payment can be made online or in the registrar's office by credit card or check.



Meals

If you do not want to bring your own lunch to camp you may purchase one through the catering company we have partnered with. You will be able to choose from several meal options, and the meals will be delivered to camp each day. All of this will be done at a reasonable cost. We will still provide an afternoon snack for all campers whether or not you purchase a lunch, or bring your own.

Health and Safety

Day Camp Sunshine is certified by the State of New Jersey and undergoes an annual inspection to ensure compliance with State guidelines. Our kitchen facilities and the pool maintenance records are inspected by State officials. We are also a member in good standing with Christian Camp and Conference Association.

Lifeguards are on duty during all swimming and water activities. Certified First Aid and CPR personnel are on duty throughout the day. Day Camp Sunshine establishes agreements with nearby medical clinics to handle emergencies, and the Liberty Corner First Aid Squad is located across the street.
